

**Southmont-Western Boone FFA
Invitational Judging Contest
Saturday March 20, 2010**

Includes: Livestock, Dairy, and Horse & Pony

New Registration Area – Community Building (inside and heated), Park near building avoid parking lot by new show arena. See map.

Place: Boone County Fairgrounds, Lebanon, IN. Located on the south edge of Lebanon, off exit 138 of Interstate 65.

Time: Registration is 8:00 AM to 8:45 AM. There is no pre-registration.

Livestock – will start at 9:00 AM. Dress for the weather; will be in open barns. Questions division will stay on the grounds and complete questions, critiques and awards in heated building. Oral reason division, we will need help transporting contestants back to WEBO High School to give reasons then critiques and awards.

Dairy – will load bus at 9:00 AM and be taken to the contest site and brought back to the fairgrounds for results. Dress for the weather. Coaches may follow in their own vehicles.

Horse & Pony – will load bus at 9:00 AM and be taken to the site. They will then be transported to Western Boone High School to give reasons. Dress for weather. Results will be presented at WEBO. Coaches may follow in their own vehicles. May need help hauling contestants.

Cost – Questions Contests (Dairy & Livestock) - \$20.00 per team of 3 or 4. Individuals - \$5.00.
Reasons Contest (Horse & Livestock) Includes a lunch - \$ 44.00 per team of 4
or \$38 per team of 3 or \$11 per individual.
